Dear Pastor Barbara,

I write to you with the understanding that you are now able to talk about the situation now that it's over, per your statement within Service on Sunday, 11/02/2025.

May I say it was a shock to hear how you've spoken of me and Christopher after our departure. We genuinely honored and respected you as a woman of God in the ministry and as the leader over the Lighthouse Church, for Christopher 32yrs, for me 18yrs.

I have spent the past 5 months in a state of shock, trying to make sense of it all, from every single lie that came forth out of your mouth, to the total dishonor of our character that came from you and your congregation. We supported and loved you all dearly and to know that we are considered to be the chief sinners and the seed of Satan, truly breaks my heart. With all we've done from our hearts to support you, your family, and the congregation over the past decade, I honestly cannot wrap all of this around my mind.

I never wanted to dishonor you while being a member at the church. My friends, family and even strangers on the internet saw the honor and respect I gave you for years of serving in the ministry. I purposely stayed to myself in the Services due to never, ever wanting to blur the lines in our relationship, meaning I never wanted to look at you as if you were just "Barbara" an ordinary person. I always wanted to keep that level of respect for you. But apparently, that was the wrong move after hearing of how you made the statement of me "always hating you". Why? Why tell your congregation something like this? Why make yourself the victim in all of this when you know the honest truth?

We wanted to leave silently. We wanted to preserve the integrity of the church but after hearing the first lie LIVE during a Service within the week of us leaving, completely sent me into confusion. I understood you didn't feel the need to respond to our resignation letter, for whatever reason; but to see how you stood before the congregation, stopping the music mid-service to tell the people we accused you of running Aaron out of the church was completely false. You implied that we confronted you and you know before God this is not true. You know we did no such thing. We NEVER confronted you; we NEVER accused you of running Aaron out of the church.

Several weeks before us leaving, I saw Christopher in distress, but I didn't know why. I knew it was bad after he came to me stating, "some things are going on in the church, but I can't tell you at the moment because I'm hoping it would stop." In this alone, Christopher was

covering for you as he always done and he wanted to protect me from being devastated behind the truth of you and Aaron's relationship. He prayed and prayed for weeks after finding out what he suspected to be true, the romance between you and Aaron. He came home saying something was not right, at a few of your meetings with you making statements like "I know you all think we (you and Aaron) are dating but we are not."



After seeing how his prayers where not being answered he shared with me the deeper truth, what you, yourself shared with him after one of the staff meetings. It was pertaining to the marriage and how you wanted to know if Aaron was still okay with it. Apparently, you could not get ahold of him, he wasn't answering your calls. Christopher being the man he is, drove to Aaron's job the next morning, congratulated him on the marriage between you and him, in which Aaron was shocked, and lost for words. To see him in this state, Christopher asked him, "Do you even love her?" and he said, "If this is what God wants..." but eventually Aaron disappeared. To be fair to you, it is wrong for Aaron to play the complete victim role in all of this. Indeed, he was not innocent.

Around the same time all of this was taking place, I noticed some things was off with you my own self, but I could not put my finger on it, but it all made sense after the truth came out. I was hopeful that you would share the truth with your congregation but that never happened. Instead, you came out with prophetic words that would make others believe we were absolutely lost and evil. This was not right, and it was all to destroy our character so those who were left would remain faithful to you.

I was hurt, not offended by your actions before leaving the church. I was hurt when you rebuked the teachings of the Storge Conference, I was hurt by you saying, the night I taught the teaching, you really didn't know where you were at. It was as if you hated the teaching and the teaching made you feel empty inside. I was shocked behind your statements after you sent me 2 emails saying "Kathryn, must teach what God has given me" and how I have to be obedient to God in doing so. Can you understand the confusion and the hurt that comes behind your actions? You rebuked the teaching that Amie gave about her dying daughter. Pastor Barbara that wasn't right and it will never be. That's hurtful to see and hear someone be so inconsiderate and not care for the death of someone's family member just so you could feel better about yourself. She showed you grace by continuing to come to church until she didn't.

I was hurt by knowing at the time, you were only concerned about Aaron what you believe God told you about the future of the Church and not necessarily the girls who you were supposed to mentor. The girls need you, that practically begged for you to have a meeting with them. Instead, you sent Theresa to talk to them and had Adriana drive you to Aaron's

house to see Adam. His family was more important than helping those girls. They saw it for it was it was and they left, not because of anything we said because we didn't say a word. They felt the rejection from you on their own.

Overall, I felt and still feel it was wrong for you to cover up the relationship that you privately developed behind closed doors and try to blame it all on us when all I did was talk to Alan, asking Him what voice were you listening too? Christopher and I received this kind of backlash from asking an honest question that should have been okay to ask. What you've done to us is not godly. WE LOVED YOU and YOU hurt us severely by acting like we were wrong for standing on integrity, leaving the church in “shambles”.

One thing I constantly hear you say is, “God told you it was going to happen.” If God told you this, which I don't think He did, why did you attack us, why did you destroy our character with the ones who remain? Why do you have to act like you've done nothing wrong and that we are evil people if God told you 6 months before we left? How come you said, we left the church in shambles? God never told you this. He never told you any such thing and this is why you've held our resignation letters to create a narrative that is not true. None of it is true, God knows this and you know this.

Here's the truth, Christopher wanted to leave the church a few years ago. I asked him to stay. I DID THAT for YOU. Christopher was hurt over and over by you, how you would talk down to him in front of the congregation and privately. You thought the jokes were funny, but they were not. It was hard for him to want to continue to serve you, not God. YOU. I watched him cry from the deepest part of his soul, due to the dishonor that you showed him over and over when all he wanted to do was YOU grow your church. You always made him feel like he didn't know what he was doing or what he was talking about. In all of the hurt, he still served with a broken heart, but we are evil? I'm so lost for words.

At this point, I honestly don't expect for you to tell the truth, but I assume your congregation thinks me, Christopher, Aaron, Adriana, Ruth, Alfonso, Neill Russell, Chris Lynch, Kierstyn, Deanna, Tianna, Vianna and Ni'Ray are all wrong. Why? You will never lie, you are always in the Spirit, you are a woman of integrity. It's as if you forgot God knows all things. God heard the intentions of your heart and saw everything you've done to keep yourself from looking ungodly and in the process, you tried to destroy our lives. It almost worked but God is able.

Though it's hard, I'm trying to forgive you, and I believe I will for my own sake. I hope one day you will tell the truth because me and Christopher will continue to speak truth as God has ordained us all to do. So, we are not doing anything against God's will. We will be speaking truth against false teachings not just in your church, but within the whole body of Christ. This is what the people of God are called to do.



You are strong, I know you will continue to fight in which I wish you the best.
